New Expansion of Broadband Internet Now Available to Residential and Business Locations in Lincoln, Spokane, and Shoshone County

Spokane, WA, April 3, 2007 – AIR-PIPE, a Dba of Wired or Wireless, Inc., recently completed two major microwave radio connection from their existing tower infrastructure to the top of the KKRS tower near Reardan, WA and to the top of Wardner Peak in Kellogg, ID. The expansion to the KKRS tower provides broadband Internet to Reardan, Wellpinit, Davenport, Nine Mile Falls, and Five Mile Falls. The Wardner Peak tower will now provide Broadband service to customers within a 15 mile range. Builders, business owners, and home owners who have a clear view to an AIR-PIPE tower now have the ability to install a broadband Internet connection at their location.

Bill Geibel Jr., Owner and Senior Engineer of AIR-PIPE, lead the team that built the network which provides service to Lincoln County and Shoshone County. He is very excited about the completion of this expansion. Bill states, “These are the 19th and 20th towers that have been added to the AIR-PIPE network and I am thrilled to expand into these areas. It is our focus to offer these thriving regions the next level of Internet connectivity.”

About AIR-PIPE, LLC - Based in Spokane, AIR-PIPE is a locally owned and operated Internet service provider. AIR-PIPE caters to rural areas by using Motorola Canopy technology to transmit a radio-wave frequency from a tower in the area to a dish installed at a subscriber’s location. Counties to which AIR-PIPE currently provide service include: Spokane, Stevens, Whitman, Bonner, Kootenai, Ponderay, and now Lincoln and Shoshone.
